



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On the Expanded Specification of Countries or Administrative Areas
at Risk of Coronavirus Infection**

As King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok has issued the announcement regarding protective measures against the spread of Coronavirus diseases 2019 (COVID-19) dated 24th February 2020, the university now deems it appropriate to modify the countries and administrative areas at risk of contracting coronavirus infection.

The University hereby invokes the authority under Article 31 (3) of the King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act B.E. 2550 in conjunction with the resolution concluded by the Policy and Planning Committee's meeting No. 7/2563 on 2nd March 2020 and declares the following:

Section 1 Besides the countries and administrative areas which have already been determined in Section 1 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Announcement on Protective Measures against the Spread of Coronavirus dated 24 February 2020, the following countries are further specified as the countries at high risk of the coronavirus infection.

- 1) Italy
- 2) Iran
- 3) France
- 4) Germany

Section 2 All personnel shall strictly comply with this announcement in order to prevent the spread of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

This announcement takes effect from 2 March 2020 onward.
