



Announcement of the KMUTNB's Committee on Prevention and Monitoring of Coronavirus Disease  
On Precautionary Measures against the More Extensive Spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

As one student of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok has been suspected of being infected by coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) due to the student's close contact with those who came back from countries at high risk of coronavirus infection. In the present, the student has already been under the Department of Disease Control's care and monitoring, and a laboratory confirmation is still in progress. Therefore, the university considers it necessary to postpone the final examination of the semester 2/2019 and to suspend all classes at KMUTNB during 10 – 15 March 2020, in order to clean and disinfect every surface and facilities both inside and outside buildings, in accordance with Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok On Precautionary Measures against the More Extensive Spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) released on 9 March 2020. The measures are implemented to monitor, prevent the spread of coronavirus, and reduce the risk of coronavirus infection and to improve safety measures for the final examination of the semester 2/2019, the arranged class schedule and academic services will be postponing to next week. This strict precautionary measures aim to promote the safety of students, staff and service recipients of the university.

In addition, the university requests cooperation from all staff to clean and disinfect both your private zone and the public zone in buildings and all facilities. Particularly, the days between 10 – 13 March 2020 are appointed as the University's Big Cleaning Day.
