



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok  
On Guidelines for Course Arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.2)

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In consequence of the recurring of coronavirus 2019 spread in Thailand, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, deems it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.2) in order to monitor and prevent the spread of coronavirus 2019, and also to ensure the efficiency of course arrangement for university students.

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act 2550 B.E., the university considers it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.2) as follows:

1. Concerning the form of course offering in the semester of 2/2020 during 4 – 31 January 2020, all theory-based subjects shall be offered via an online platform both in graduate and undergraduate levels. For practiced-based subjects, the academic section shall consider the form of course arrangement as convenient, but the social distancing measures and protective measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 have to be strictly observed until the situation improves or the next announcement specify otherwise.

2. Regarding the internship, co-operative studies or other equivalent subjects, the relevant academic section and supervisor shall cooperate with the organization outside the university to evaluate the risk of students in contracting coronavirus 2019. If the risk is found, other activities should be considered to replace, such as assigning students to work from home. As long as the situation improves or the next announcement specify otherwise, the safety of student has to be considered as a priority.

3. For the conduct of special project, thesis, dissertation, special issue or other equivalent subjects, the students can visit the university to carry out necessary tasks if required. The relevant section has to implement protective measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 and social distancing measures, as well as to set up a screening point in order to decrease the risk of infection in students, personnel and other related parties.

4. In regard to educational measurement and evaluation, the academic section and other sections related to course offering shall employ the appropriate form of educational measurement and evaluation in consideration of the context of each subject, in order to achieve the learning objectives as specified in the curriculum. Also, the coronavirus 2019 situation, social distancing and protective measures, the

convenience of students and lecturers, the preparedness of place and equipment, as well as the effectiveness of online educational measurements and evaluation, have to be considered.

5. The usage of laboratories in the universities has to comply with the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on Guidelines for the Usage of Laboratories in King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok during the outbreak of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), announced on 17 June 2020.

6. The head of the academic section has an authority to consider the convenient from of course offering and its arrangement. In case that any troubles or obstacles arise in consequence of the implementation of practice prescribed in this announcement, the department head has an authority to make a final decision.

This announcement takes effect from now on.
