



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On Guidelines for Course Arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.4)

In consequence of the recurring of coronavirus 2019 spread in Thailand, in order to monitor and prevent the spread of coronavirus 2019, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, deems it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.4) to ensure the efficiency of course arrangement for university students.

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act 2550 B.E., the university considers it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.4) as follows:

1. Concerning the form of course offering in the semester of 2/2020 during 4 – 31 January 2021, the theory-based courses at all level have to be offered onsite, and also the practice-based courses at all level should be offered online, or other assignments may be given instead, until 31 January 2021 or the new issued announcement specifies otherwise.
2. For cooperative education, internship or other equivalent courses, the academic sections and lecturers, together with enterprises that students are going to do an internship, shall consider to adjust the form of the program, such as assign the student to work from home or other assignments may be given, until the situation improves or the new announcement specifies otherwise. The safety of students has to be a priority and be focused on.
3. For the special project, thesis, dissertation, special topic, independent study or other equivalent courses shall be offered online until 31 January 2021 or the new announcement specifies otherwise.
4. The conduct of experiment in laboratories shall be postponed until 31 January 2021 or until the new announcement specifies otherwise.

This announcement takes effect from 18 January 2021 onwards.
