



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok  
On Guidelines for Course Arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.5)

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In consequence of the recurring of coronavirus 2019 spread in Thailand, in order to monitor and prevent the spread of coronavirus 2019, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, deems it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.5) to ensure the efficiency of course arrangement for university students.

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act 2550 B.E., the university considers it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement in the semester of 2/2020 (No.5) as follows:

1. Concerning the form of course offering in the semester of 2/2020 during 4 – 31 January 2021, the practiced-based subjects that requires the use of laboratories can be offered on-site, but the social distancing, screening and protective measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 shall be strictly complied.

In case that the students cannot come to the university to attend practice-based classes at the university, the students have to inform the lecturer of that course, so that the lecturer can consult with the head of the academic section to consider the convenient means for course offering in that case.

2. All theory-based subjects shall be offered only via an online platform.

3. Regarding the evaluation and assessment by the arrangement of mid-term examination, the academic and other relevant sections shall consider to adjust the form of evaluation and assessment as appropriate to context in order to achieve the specified learning objectives, such as online examination, assignment, report and take-home examination, as well as the evaluation and assessment should be carried out regularly. It is suggested that the evaluation should not be restricted to the form of examination. Above all, due to the current situation of coronavirus 2019 spread, precautionary and social distancing measures should be complied in order to avoid the overcrowding.

In case that the assessment is adjusted, the academic and relevant sections have to inform the students about the change of assessment.

4. The conduct of experiment in laboratories as a part of the student's research in the university can be carried out only in some necessary cases, each laboratory shall specify precautionary measures which the student has to strictly observe all the time during the use of laboratory.

5. The use of laboratories within the university for education and research has to comply to Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on Guidelines for the Use of the University's Laboratories during the spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) dated 17 June 2021.

6. The academic section head has an authority to consider the convenient form course and mid-term examination arrangement, as well as the evaluation. In case that any problem arises from the implementation of the guidelines specified in this announcement, the academic section head has an authority to make a final decision.

This announcement takes effect from 1-12 February 2021 or until the next announcement specify otherwise.
