



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok  
On Guidelines for the Working Practices of the University Staff during the Semester 2/2020  
(No. 5)

As the recurring of wider spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) has been occurred in Thailand, it is important to ensure that the working practices of the university staff during the semester 2/2020 comply with the precautionary measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019. So the university deems it appropriate to issue an announcement on guidelines for the working practices of the university staff during the semester 2/2020 (No. 5).

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act B.E. 2550, the university deems it appropriate to issue the announcement on guidelines for the working practices for the university staff during the semester 2/2020 (No. 5) as follows:

1. All of the university's personnel shall work at the university as usual, but precautionary measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) prescribed by the Ministry of Public Health have to be complied. The traveling to or participation in any activities in the high risk or crowded should be avoided. Also, the social distancing and protective measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) shall be maintained and strictly observed.

In case that the personnel cannot come to work at the office, the section heads shall consider to specify the working practice for the staff in each case.

2. The arrangement of activities both inside and outside the university that will result in mass gathering has to be abstained. If it is necessary to arrange such activities that require the attendance of a large group of people, the online platform is advised to be used.

3. The usage of laboratories in the university has to comply with the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on Guidelines for the Laboratories' Usage during the spread of coronavirus 2029 (COVID-19), announced on 17 June 2020.

This announcement takes effect from 13 February 2021 or until the new announcement is issued.
