



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On the class and academic activity arrangement policy
during the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (Announcement No. 2)

Referring to the previous announcement regarding the class and academic activity arrangement policy during the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), signed 18th March 2020, the 3rd video conference of KMUTNB council has grant a resolution on 7th April 2020, to alter the academic schedule due to the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and also announced the emergency decree across Kingdom of Thailand. King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok has acted accordingly which resulted in implementation of KMUTNB updated guidelines on class and academic activity arrangement as follows;

1. The academic schedule of semester 2 and summer semester of academic year 2019 will be maintained and executed as stated in the previous resolution of the KMUTNB Council. Furthermore, the aforementioned academic schedules are subject to change depend on the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) severity which the government should officially notify the university of further measures. As a result, KMUTNB will adjust the academic schedules accordingly.

2. The academic performance measurement and assessment period of semester 2 and summer semester will be extended regarding the grading transition of "I" to "F" or "U", including the deadlines of special project and thesis evaluation; thesis, research, independent study approval and final submission date. As stated in KMUTNB's act regarding the rules of vocational certificate, bachelor and post graduate, the grading period within 30 days counted after the academic result approval date of semester 2 and summer semester of academic year 2019 will be extended to 60 days instead.

3. The internship, cooperative education programs and other equivalent programs which are opened for summer semester of academic year 2019 will collaborate with external organizations, divisions or companies to consider the “Work From Home” policy in order to appropriately adjust and assign the activity and project work with the safety of student and staff in mind. In some circumstances, the postponement of the internship, cooperative education programs and other equivalent programs should be taken into consideration which the university extends the period of these programs until the last summer semester of senior year.

4. The honors reception of graduates will be specifically considering the students who are on the process of special project or thesis evaluation during the academic result approval date extension as stated in topic No. 2 or the students who transfer the enrollment of the internship, cooperative education programs and other equivalent programs to the last summer semester of academic year 2020 by the virtue of KMUTNB act on diploma education, 2009.

This announcement is to inform and must be strictly abided.
