



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On Guidelines for the Education Arrangement in the Semester 1/2020 (No.2)**

In reference to the announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on Guidelines for Education Arrangement in the semester 1/2020 dated June 2020 which prescribes guidelines for course arrangement in the semester 1/2020 during the spread of coronavirus 2019 disease (COVID - 19), the special committee to consider relaxing the enforcement of certain protective measures against COVID-19 has agreed to relax measures concerning education arrangement and the higher education institutions are allowed to offer courses and arrange activities both onsite and online as convenience. King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, therefore, deems it appropriate to additionally modify guidelines on course arrangement in the semester 1/2020 and faculties, colleges and academic sections can fully offer courses onsite as usual.

However, faculties, colleges and academic sections must have a plan to monitor and implement protective measures in case that the coronavirus widely spread again, and also have to be prepared to offer courses fully online or in combination between online and onsite if necessary. Furthermore, faculties, colleges and academic sections have to strictly implement social distancing measure and continue the same level of monitoring coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).

This announcement takes effect from 13 August 2020 onward.
