



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On the University's Opening during the Spread of Coronavirus 2019

King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok will be opened from 1 November onwards in compliance with guidelines and criteria for the opening of the educational institutions under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation (MHESI), as the spread of coronavirus 2019 has been resolved and the venues of educational institutions are allowed to open. Therefore, this announcement is issued to ensure the efficiency of the university's operation and to prevent the spread of the coronavirus 2019 disease.

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act B.E. 2550, the university deems it appropriate to issue the announcement as follows:

1. The venues of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok (Bangkok Campus, Prachinburi Campus, Rayong Campus and Human Resource Training Center for Industry Maptaput) shall be opened from 1 November 2021 onwards.
2. Heads of offices, supervising vice presidents or assistants to the president will consider allowing the personnel to station at the offices and work from home as necessary and appropriate to the office's operation.
3. The personnel who shall be allow to at the office has to be fully vaccinated. In addition, they must strictly observe social distancing practices and preventive measures against the spread of coronavirus 20219.
4. The university's personnel shall strictly observe this announcement.

5. In case that any troubles arise from the implementation of this announcement, heads of offices, supervising vice presidents or assistants to the president have the authority to fix manage as appropriate and inform the case to the president.

This announcement takes effect from 1 – 30 November 2021 or until the newly issued announcement specifies otherwise.
