



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On the University's Opening during the Spread of Coronavirus 2019 (No.4)

According to the previous announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on the University's Opening during the Spread of Coronavirus 2019 (No.3) dated December 28, 2021 and regulation issued under section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No.41) enforced by the Thai Government Gazette dated January 8, 2022, the university must provide the guidelines and working measures of the staff under the consideration of working from home policy depending on the proper circumstances under the supervision of the university until January 31, 2022 in compliance with guidelines and criteria for the opening of the educational institutions under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation (MHESI).

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act 2550 B.E., the university considers it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement as follows:

1. The director of the department/division, vice president, or assistant to president has the authority to superintend and consider the working ratio of the staff under supervision not to exceed 50 percent to prevent the damage that could affect to the university operation.

2. Other circumstances that is not mentioned in this announcement must the university staff must adhere to the specified details in No. 3, 4 and 5 of the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok on the University's Opening during the Spread of Coronavirus 2019 dated October 27, 2021.

This announcement takes effect from 16 – 31 January 2022 or until the newly issued announcement specify otherwise.
