Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On Guidelines for Course Arrangement in the semester of 1/2021 (No.3)

In consequence of the recurring of coronavirus 2019 outbreak in Bangkok Metropolitan and provincial areas has been severely increased the cases across Thailand, in order to monitor and prevent the spread of coronavirus 2019, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, deems it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement to ensure the efficiency and safety for the students.

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act 2550 B.E., the university considers it appropriate to specify the guidelines for course arrangement as follows:

1. Concerning the form of course arrangement in the semester of 1/2021, all vocational certificate courses of Pre-engineering, undergraduate level, and graduate level shall be offered via an online platform until September 30, 2021. Should the circumstances of the coronavirus 2019 outbreak relieve, departments are allowed to alter and adapt the courses depending on the situation

2. Regarding the midterm examination assessment, the vocational certificate of Pre-engineering in all departments, undergraduate level, and graduate level shall offer the examination assessment via online platform. The departments are allowed to alter and adapt the assessment methods in other various forms such as substitute assignment, report, physical copy of take-home examination, and oral examination. However, departments shall inform the students beforehand of the alteration of assessment criteria of each subject.

3. The physical course arrangement and assessment examination in the university area is prohibited until the coronavirus 2019 outbreak situation relieves or the next announcement specify otherwise.

4. Regarding the internship, co-operative studies or other equivalent subjects, the relevant academic section and supervisor shall cooperate with the organization outside the university to alter the activities such as assigning students to work from home or working via online platform until the coronavirus 2019 outbreak situation relieves, or the next announcement specify otherwise.

5. Before procedures are applied or taken into action, it is considered accountable for strict coronavirus disease 2019 public health and social distancing measures for the utmost safety of university staff and students.

This announcement takes effect from 27 July 2021 until the next announcement specify otherwise.
