Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
On the University's Temporary Closure due to the Recurring Spread of Coronavirus 2021
(No. 2)

As King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok has issued an announcement on the university's temporary closure due to the recurring spread of coronavirus 2021 (No. 1) dated 9 April 2021, it is apparent that the coronavirus 2019 is still widely spreading in Bangkok and other provinces. Therefore, the university considers it importance to implement certain measures in order to prevent the spread of coronavirus 2019 and to ensure the safety of the university's students and staff,

By virtue of Section 31 (3) of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok's Act B.E. 2550, the university deems it appropriate to issue the announcement as follows:

1. King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok (Bangkok Campus) will be temporarily closed from 22 – 30 April 2021 (extending the closure period from the date as specified in the previous announcement issued on 9 April 2021) For the Rayong Campus, Prachinburi Campus and Human Resource Training Center for Industry Maptaput, they will be temporarily closed from 16 – 30 April 2021.
2. The academic sections in Bangkok Campus, Prachinburi Campus and Rayong Campus shall offer all courses by means of online platform.
3. The personnel of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok shall work from home during 22 – 30 April 2021 (extending the working from home period from the date as specified in the previous announcement issued on 9 April 2021). For the personnel in Rayong Campus, Prachinburi Campus and Human Resource Training Center for Industry Maptaput, they shall work from home during 16 – 30 April 2021.

The heads of working sections or offices shall consider to assign work to each staff according to their duties, but the staff while working from home has to be ready for receiving communications or orders from their supervisors or related people at all time.

In case of emergency or necessity, in order to ensure the sufficiency of the university's or office's operation, the supervisors can call for an online meeting or consult with any staff by means of electronic platform at all time during office hours, or may order any staff to station at the office as necessary by an approval of the supervising Vice President or head of the office. The staff who finds it necessary to work at the university has to strictly observe the protective measures against the spread of coronavirus 2019 as specified by the Ministry of Public Health.

4. The students and staff have to avoid traveling or engage in any activities in the crowded areas, and to closely follow information or announcement released by the university.
5. The arrangement of any activities that will result in a gathering of many people both inside and outside the university has to be suspended, or it may be arranged by means of online platform.
6. The university's personnel has to strictly observe this announcement.
7. In case that any problems arise from the implementation of this announcement, the Vice President in charge of supervising the office has the authority to make a decision as appropriate and report the case to the President.

This announcement takes effect from 16 - 30 April 2021 or until the newly issued announcement specifies otherwise.
